NSW POLICE VISION ASSESSMENT

IMPORTANT

This Police Vision Assessment is to be conducted a by qualified Optometrist only. Please read instructions thoroughly.

This form is to be used for all applicants who cannot pass the police vision standards unaided (without glasses).

Police standards require vision to be 6/9 for left and right eye individually and 6/6 when both eyes being used together. Near vision must be N9.

Please note initial vision assessment cost will be met by Recovre on the condition that the applicant has arranged their NSW Police medical examination with Recovre. Please be advised that if further assessment is requested, an additional file review charge will be required prior to the report being reviewed.

POLYCARBONATE GLASSES

All applicants requiring visual correction are required to have a pair of spectacles of coated polycarbonate material. This includes those applicants who plan to wear contact lenses on duty.

COLOUR VISION (Ishihara test – either 24 or 38 plate)

Applicants with protan defect are unlikely to be able to proceed.

SURGICAL PROCEDURES
